



Internship Opportunities

Background: The AIA Academy, which is the community outreach division of the Arizona Interscholastic Association, provides educational programming and services to assist coaches, parents and youth sport organizations in creating a healthy physical activity and positive youth sport experience for children and adolescents.

Introduction: This internship program will benefit the student by identifying and then fostering the student's unique abilities, interests, and passion for creating a positive youth sport experience and then matching these talents to the AIA Academy's varied needs. The AIA Academy internship program provides an excellent opportunity for students to gain experience related to the implementation of parent and coach education programming and healthy lifestyle projects in a statewide non-profit organization.

Duties: The duties and responsibilities of the intern may include, but are not limited to:

- Assisting in the creation of promotion and marketing tools
- Web-based research for current youth health related topics
- Assistance in the logistics and implementation of AIA Academy events and services in the community
- Assistance in the collection and recording of research and evaluation data
- Administrative assistance duties

Hours: Interns are required to work a specific number of hours per week specified by the school internship program. Specific scheduling will be arranged with the Internship Program Manager.

Compensation: Upon completion of all assigned responsibilities, qualified interns will receive the predetermined agreed upon academic credit commensurate with the student intern program guidelines.
